### COVID-19 Situation/ Vaccination Program

### **◆ COVID-19 Situation**

- Coronavirus outbreak and new virus continue to spread despite vaccination(Cases: 151,506, Death: 2,004/As of June 22)
- Social distancing, bans on gatherings continue (reorganization to be eased from (5 July, Not confirmed)

### Vaccination Program

- Primary vaccination (15,014,819/ 28.97%), Secondary(4,047,846/7.81%)
- Goal of forming herd immunity in November by increasing the speed of vaccination (Government)
- Only those who have completed corona vaccination abroad, when entering Korea, Excluded from quarantine (from July 1)
- Exemption from entry from countries where the variant virus is prevalent (13 countries)

## MSO Planned/ Proposed Activity (1/3)

- ◆ MSO ministry promotion strategy under COVID-19
  - Sharing all information through SNS, Email, Kato, Band, WhatsApp, VTC, and others' IT systems
  - Online and VTC Connection with MSO ministry strategic areas (Indochina, Central Asia, Middle East, etc.) and VPs / MCFs
  - Developing Online Training systems for oversea military ministry for MEO-P
  - Customized Online System and Digital platform for Post COVID preparation as information technologe(IT)
  - Prayer Meeting and P&P (Every Thursday 06:30/ Online)
    - Overcome prayer and worship activities online (average weekly attendance: 40~50 MSO members)

# MSO Planned/ Proposed Activity (2/3)

- **♦ MSO** evangelism and visiting activities (online/face-to-face)
  - Area visits to the former Soviet Union (MSO cooperative missionaries have been conducting since May)
  - The Indochina region was postponed to the second half of the year due to the Myanmar crisis.
  - MSO executives evangelism and visiting overseas mission fields (overcoming online)
  - Most of the meeting/competition activities are prepared and conducted by online.
    - Korean World Missionary Conference: 13<sup>th~</sup> 16<sup>th</sup> July. (face-to-face/online).
    - Central Asia Regional Conference: 24<sup>th</sup> July. Kyrgyzstan, (face-to-face/online)
    - East Asia Interaction: September 25. (Online)/ Hosted by VP Andrew Tzeng.

## MSO Planned/ Proposed Activity (3/3)

- ◆ Planned MEO-P 2021 will be held in 2 groups by online
  - First group: 11<sup>th</sup> ~13<sup>th</sup> Oct: 11 people from 7 countries in Africa
  - Second group: 14th ~16th Oct: 17 people from 11 other countries
  - ★ The online method and training process for the education of 28 people in 18 countries continues to develop
  - ★ Share the final schedule to ACCTS and MMI for their introduction
- ♦ New FMC-K(Foreign Military Christian in Korea) Interaction promotes online and face-to-face training(76 people from 18 countries)
  - 1st FMC-K Interaction: Online 24th July. 31st July/ Offline 6th ~ 8th Aug. Jeju Island/24 people from 11 countries
  - 2nd FMC-K Interaction: Online 21st Aug. 28th Aug/ Offline 3rd~5th Aug. Jeju Island/ 38 people from 15 countries

### MSO Second Half Ministry/Prayer Request

#### ◆ 2021 Second half of Ministry

- Strengthening cooperation between AMCF and 3PSO (WC preparation, interaction, regional conference, participation in national meeting, etc.)
- Active promotion of MSO planned ministries (FMC-K Interaction, MEO-P 2021)
