I'd ask regional VPs and PSOs to complete the attached Recommendation Form for the applicants to the 2023 MEO-P and send them to the MSO by the end of February 2023. MSO will review the letters of recommendation in accordance with the prescribed procedure to determine whether or not they are eligible to attend the Program.

Even when national MCF presidents or Korean cooperative missionaries recommend applicants, I would also like to ask you to make sure that their letters of recommendation be submitted to the MSO through the corresponding VPs or PSOs.

I pray that God's blessings and grace will always be with you, your family, your military, and your country.

## MEO-P'23 Plan and Delegate Selection Plan

#### 1. The objective

- a. To invite the military Christian delegates from non/weak MCF countries.
- b. To provide opportunities for observing Korean military evangelism and for receiving discipleship training program.
- c. To assist the new establishment and growth of the participants' MCFs.
- **2. Period**: June 19(Mon)~26(Mon), 2023 (8 days)
- 3. Venue: Navy Central Chapel (Seoul, Korea)
- **4. Host:** Mission Support Organization (MSO)
- **5. Instructor:** ACCTS, MMI and MSO instructors as the CATT

#### 6. Major activities

- a. Introduction Lectures: Introductions to AMCF, ACCTS, MMI, MSO, Korean military ministry -related Organizations (KMCF, KVMCF, MEAK, Military Chaplain Corps), and Korean Military Missionary Development
- b. Discipleship Training: IBS/CP, Biblical Leadership, Personal Evangelism, and Personal Testimony, Establishment and Growth of MCF, Biblical Ethics
- c. Group Discussion/presentation: IBS/CP, National Report
- d. Field Trip and Observation
  - Frontline Ministerial Spots and National Salvation Prayer Convention, and the War Memorial Hall
  - Observation of the Baptismal Ceremony at a Military Chapel, Visit to some Military or private churches, etc.

#### 7. Delegates Selection Criteria

- a. Delegate size: around 20 people
- b. Priority for the invitation
  - 1) 1 or 2 delegates from non-MCF countries
    - Applicants participating from countries where no MCF has been established must be recommended by the region VP or PSO.
  - 2) 1 or 2 delegates from weak-MCF countries
    - Applicants participating in countries with weak MCF activities must also be recommended by the region VP or PSO.
  - 3) Delegates recommended by national MCF presidents or Korean cooperative missionaries
    - Even when recommended by the MCF president or Korean cooperative missionary of a country, the letters of recommendation must be submitted through the regional VP or PSO.

#### 8. Principle of financial support

- a. For delegates from non-MCF and weak MCF countries who are not self-sponsored, MSO provides all the expenses including round trip air tickets, accommodations, meals and local transportation during the MEO Program, except registration fee (US \$30)
- b. The delegates who want to participate in MEO Program as an observer or as self-sponsored, are also provided with accommodations, meals and local transportation during the MEO Program, but should pay registration fee (US \$30).

#### 9. Requirement for Cooperation

#### a. Request for AMCF regional VPs and PSO' cooperation

- The AMCF VPs and the PSOs: fill out the recommendation form for each of the delegate applicants and submit them to the MSO office by the end of February 2023.
- 2) Final selection: by MSO P&P in March 2023.

#### b. Cooperation Request to ACCTS and MMI

- 1) MSO cordially invites one ACCTS staff as a lecturer for the introduction to ACCTS and Personal Testimony.
- 2) MSO cordially invites one MMI staff as a lecturer for the introduction to MMI and Conversational Prayer.
- 3) MSO also recommends ACCTS and MMI to send us the list of potential participants no later than the end of February 2023.
