Brief report of activities carried out

1. Introduction

Associação de Militares Cristianos de Moçambique (AMCM) is a non-profit organization, created in 2013, with the aim of winning souls for Jesus in the Mozambican Armed Defense Forces. This organization, despite being functioning, still needs to be legalized.

It is made up of 87 active members, spread across various military units within the country. The active members, in their daily lives and in the military units where they are assigned, try to evangelize their colleagues.

2. our activities

a) Monthly Meetings

AAMCM members meet once a month in predefined locations for prayer in favor of:

- (i) from the AMCF of Mozambique and around the world,
- (ii) of the Mozambican government,
- (iii) the end of the end of the war in Cabo Delgado, in the north of the country,
- (iv) of our families

It should be noted that in these meetings, new members are introduced and integrated into the organization where they receive physical and electronic bibles and newspapers.





a) Partnerships

AMCM has maintained partnerships with other Christian entities listed below to revitalize its activities:

(i) Full Life Foundation

This foundation is headed by Bishop Emeritus Dom Dinis Sengulane. Through this foundation, AMCM receives counseling, teaching the word of God, exchanging experiences in various domains.

(ii) Roger Kahler from Australia

This brother, in 2016, offered our association 15,000 bibles with camouflaged cover, a stock that came to leverage our work of evangelization that is done, not only in the Armed Forces but also in all defense and security forces in Mozambique, namely: (Police, Firefighters, Prison Guards, Guards from Private Institutions and Former Combatants);

It should be noted that the bibles have already been distributed throughout the country through small groups existing in each province.







(iii) USA brothers

In coordination with the MEP (Evangelical Military of Portugal), the association received 1000 New Testament Electronic Bibles with 500 "Desafio" Newspapers containing testimonies from AMCF from all over the world, including that of Sister Felicina, President of AMCM and Focal Point for Angola and Sao Tome and Principe.





3. Participation in national and international conferences

In 2018, a conference was held in Mozambique, where Mr. Samuel Coias, Lieutenant Colonel, MMI Staff for Lusophone Africa and Peter Lowrence, CP AMCF Africa South, Archbishop of the Anglican Church, Dom Carlos Matsinhe, Archbishop Emeritus, Dom Dinis Sengulane, Reverend Valente Tseco, President of the Bible Society of Mozambique and also Pastors of the Evangelical Church Assembly of God of Mozambique.
