## 2023 Military Evangelism Observation (MEO) Program to Be Held.

MEO-P will be held at ROK Naval Central Church (Singil-dong, Seoul) from June 19th to 26th. 7 delegates from 5 African countries and 8 from 5 Asian countries will participate.

As for instructors, the ACCTS (1 instructor), the MMI (1 instructor), and the MSO (14 instructors) will form a Combined Assistance & Training Team (CATT) to provide education and training support.

From 09:00 to 12:00 on June 22 (Thu), the AMCF Leaders' Meeting is to be held with AMCF President General Essel Soriano presiding, attended by ACCTS Chairman Phil Exner, MMI Representative Mark Chester, and MSO Chairman Nam-pil Park. At this AMCF Leaders' Meeting, various matters for preparation for the AMCF World Conference 2024 to be held in Sao Paulo, Brazil will be discussed.

Iraq in the Middle East and Equatorial Guinea in Africa, where their MCFs have not been established, are dispatching their delegates to 2023 MEO-P. We sincerely hope that MCFs will be established in these countries with God's guidance and through the devotional efforts of the delegates of these countries.

## 2 Cornelius Discipleship Training Hosted by Country "V" MCF

The V Country MCF Discipleship Training was conducted for the purpose of nurturing next-generation leaders by vitalizing meetings through practical discipleship training for MCF growth and carrying out leader-centered training.

This discipleship training was conducted from May 9th to 19th with the sponsorship and support of the MSO for about 40 military Christians of "V" attended.

Through this training, the MCF of "V" country secured a stable place for education and training and created conditions for online and offline education through the Internet. In addition, four MCF regional branches were established. In the second half of this year the President of the "V" MCF will hold an online meeting with the purpose to include the discussion results in the next year's discipleship training program.

The "V" MCF has a plan to conduct 2024 Cornelius Discipleship Training online as well as off line; find and nurture new generation leaders, and share ministry activities with the MCFs of the neighboring countries.

## 3 A Discipleship Training Conducted in the CIS Countries

In April, a nurturing meeting was held through Happiness School in "S" Country, followed by a course for spiritual revival of Christian soldiers and raising leaders through Heaven's Citizen School in "J" Country from May to early June.

The MSO will offer the 2023 MEO delegates of the CIS (Commonwealth of Independent States) Countries the opportunity to visit Korean churches in June. MSO will continue to support and pray that safe training and nurturing courses will be established for the revitalization of the MCFs in these countries.

## 4 Visits Paid to the MSO

a. On May 8th, Pastor Dong-hwa Tae (Secretary General of the Methodist Missionary Bureau) visited the MSO with 7 students of Methodist Theological Seminary University and received an introduction to AMCF and MSO.

b. On June 9, Missionary Bu-heung Yoo from "K" Country visited the MSO. MSO Chairman

Nam-pil Park and World Mission Bureau Director Yong-kwan Chang welcomed him and discussed cooperation plans with him.



## 5 Activities Concerning AMCF

### a. Attended the AMCF P&P for Brazilian World Conference 2024, Online

On May 18th, the Pray and Plan for the World Conference 2024 was held with AMCF President General Essel Soriano presiding. From MSO, Standing Advisor General Lee, Gap-jin and 4 members of the preparatory committee participated. The WC 2024 will be held in Sao Paulo, Brazil in October 2024. The Brazilian Preparatory Committee, the Regional VP and 3 PSOs have decided to actively support and participate in the preparing activities.

### b. 2023 East Asia Interaction and STANDART to be Held

The 2023 East Asia Interaction and STANDART Conference will be held for 4 days from September 7th (Thu) to September 10th (Sun), co-hosted by Andrew Tzeng, Vice President of AMCF East Asia Region, and the Chairman of Kyrgyzstan MCF. The Interaction and the Conference will be conducted for the purpose of spiritual revival and leader training for Christian soldiers who have been shrunk due to COVID-19. This event is also planned to commemorate the 25th anniversary of Kyrgyzstan MCF.



### c. Attended Philippine MCF Watch and Pray (online)

On May 21st, AMCF President, MG. Soriano, hosted a Philippine MCF meeting where LtGen Kap-jin Lee an MSO Standing Advisor, was invited. The Philippine MCF prayed together for the successful conduct of the 2023 MEO-P. LtGen. Lee prayed for the smooth and perfect preparation of the World Conference 2024.



### d. Attended West Africa Regional Pray (online)

On May 28th, MSO Africa West and South Team leader Hyun-chul Lee participated in the Africa West region regular prayer meeting, hosted by General Mike Akpatsu, Vice President of West Africa Region. At the prayer meeting, the participants discussed how to support 2023 MEO-P participants, other pending issues which should be dealt with at a regular quarterly prayer meeting, and how to promote the vitalization of the National MCFs in Africa West.



## 6 The Surgery Date for Ugandan LT. Jude Wandera at Severance Hospital Confirmed

Lieutenant Jude Wandera, who suffered severe facial gunshot wounds while on a unit mission in September, 2022, continued to receive treatment and surgery at a Ugandan military hospital. However, as more surgeries were needed (plastic surgery, dental prosthetics, etc.) that exceeded his economic ability, the doctors of the Ugandan Ministry of Health, who had completed medical training in Korea, requested Korean medical institutions to allow Lieutenant Jude to undergo additional surgeries.

Thanks to the efforts of the Medical Mission Center of Yonsei Medical Center and the Institute of Tropical Medicine, College of Medicine of Yonsei University, Lieutenant Jude was able to undergo surgery at Severance Hospital. He will visit Korea with his wife and receive the first surgery for 2 weeks free of charge from June 24 to July 13 at Severance Hospital (Seoul) in Korea supported by the Global Severance Charity Program (after 3 months 2nd surgery scheduled).

The MSO is overseeing the invitation procedures of Lt. Jude and his wife. MSO team leader of Africa East and Francophone, Moon-soo Yoon (visiting professor at Yonsei University), is in charge of all tasks, including arrival at and departure from the airport, and accommodations before and after hospitalization, in cooperation with the social work team of Severance Hospital.

The MSO asks for your prayers so that Lt. Jude will return home after successfully undergoing surgery at Severance Hospital with God's guidance.

- ③ that Brazilian Politics and economy will be stabilized where the 2024 AMCF World Conference is to be held and that the WC preparation committee and the Brazilian MCF (UMCEB) will decide the conference schedule, venue, and budget for the World Conference as soon as possible;
- ④ for national MCF presidents and leaders;
- ⑤ that the Lord may protect and guide Ukrainian chaplains and Christian soldiers who are serving on the battlefield;
- ⑥ that Interaction-Rocky Mountain High (June 8~21) conducted by ACCTS proceeds safely and effectively;
- ⑦ for the speedy recovery of Uzbekistan MCF President.

- ① that all the participants in the 2023 MEO-P are nurtured as spiritual military Christian leaders to contribute to the establishment and activation of MCFs in their countries;
