
I hope you are well. As far as my team is concerned, there is much to share about the past few months. I am grateful to be able to share some of the wonderful things the Lord has been doing.







Training

The NLTC (New Life Training Center) training is one of the most important means of ensuring the spiritual health of the people who serve in the Military Movement. Through this training, our disciples are able to grow in their faith.

A total of 21 disciples attend this year's NLTC training. Some of the topics we have taught are: How to be led by the Holy Spirit; How to share Christ with others; Why do we need to make disciples?; How to be a faithful steward of the Lord. During the training, we split up into 4 groups and applied what we had learnt by going out into the streets to share the gospel. We were able to tell 16 people about Jesus Christ, and 7 of them professed faith in Him. We connected those people with local churches. Our disciples shared with us that they clearly felt the Holy Spirit helping them when they told others about Christ.

'Let's Date with Love' program.

Our young officers' team ran a program called 'Let's Date with Love" for followers of Christ. This is what they did. First they taught a lesson about the five love languages and then they gave the learners time to express their feelings to each other; this time was very precious to them. Two of the couples that attended the program were not believers. For them it was the first time they had participated in a program with Christians. Afterwards, they commented: "We have learnt that believing in Christ is not a religion. We had never realized that it was something so real and that it was connected with our everyday life."







Staff prayer time

On 12 October, MKKK (Mongolian Campus for Christ) took part in a worldwide time of prayer. World Prayer is a day when in every country our international organization ministers, staff gather to pray for the nations. Our team prayed especially for Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and North Kor ea during this time.

On 31 October, we left Ulaanbaatar to go on a silent retreat. For those of us who serve God full time, dependence on the Lord is very important. On this day, we set aside time to spend with God individually, after which we shared our experiences with the rest of the group and prayed. Through this time, our team got to know one another even better; it was a special time of intimate fellowship.
